**Non-Agenda Public Comment:**

On February 20, 2008 René left a voice mail message with Mr. Lottermoser, stating that the case had already been discussed at this subcommittee, and a motion was generated and passed by the full board. René mentioned that at the time of this meeting, he has not had any response to either request.

**New Business:**

- A. Stop Sign at Meade Avenue and Ohio Street) The constituent was not present, and Sal mentioned that he received an email from constituent Travis Gregory, stating that "so far, it hasn't been as bad as I had initially thought. I was thinking it would be a lot noisier".
